You have been shortlisted to appear for the written test for admission to the M.Tech. (Biomedical Engineering) Program for the academic year 2025-26. Further, upon qualifying the written test, you will be invited for an interview. Both written test and interview will be held in-person (i.e., offline).

WRITTEN TEST (In-Person)

Date of written test: Thursday, 8th May 2025

Venue: Room LA001, Ground Floor, Lecture Hall Complex L3 (near the Departments of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering), IIT Bombay campus.

Reporting time: 8:30 am (for document verification)

Written Test: 10:00 am to 11:00 am [for benchmark disability (PwD) candidates: 20 min per hour compensatory time as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment i.e. 10:00 am to 11:20 am].

Documents to be produced for verification:

- a) A copy of the application form for admission to this program
- b) Call letter for written test/interview
- c) Proof of identity
- d) Original certificates of educational qualification
- e) Proof of date of birth
- f) Valid GATE/NEET PG/NEET MDS/GPAT score card (in case of NEET PG/MDS exam not conducted for current year, you have to produce valid admit card AND self-declaration in the specified format)
- g) Sponsorship certificate from present employer in the specified format (for candidates under Sponsored (SW) category)
- h) Valid caste certificate supporting birth category (SC, ST, OBC-NC), benchmark disability (PwD), EWS status

Candidates awaiting results of qualifying examination: If selected, your admission will be provisional, subject to meeting the eligibility criteria available at this URL:

Written test will have the following six sections and a candidate has to choose any two (2) of the following six (6) sections for writing the exam:

1. Biology
2. Chemistry
3. Physics
4. Mathematics
5. Physiology
6. Engineering (Section 6A or Section 6B).

Please note: Candidates who choose the Engineering section have to **choose either Section 6A (Electrical Engineering and allied branches) OR Section 6B (Mechanical/ Chemical Engineering and allied branches).**

- The candidates may choose any two sections irrespective of their qualifying degree. Only the two sections chosen by the candidate should be attempted and will be evaluated (e.g. Biology and Engineering-Section 6A OR Chemistry and Physics OR Physiology and Engineering-Section 6B, etc.).
- The question paper for each section will comprise of 10 questions, 1 mark each. There will be no negative marking.
- Syllabus for each section will be at a level comparable to that of the latest GATE examination or equivalent test/exam. The syllabus for each section is given at <https://www.bio.iitb.ac.in/web/Written Test Syllabus MTech.pdf>
- Use of a scientific calculator (equivalent to Casio FX-82MS or lower models) during the written test will be permitted. **Candidates should bring their own scientific calculator. Mobile phones, smartwatches, earphones or any other electronic gadgets will not be allowed during the exam.**

INTERVIEW (In-Person; ONLY for candidates shortlisted based on written test)

Date of interview: Friday, 9th May 2025 (9:00 am onwards)

Venue: Department of Biosciences and Bioengineering


Candidates who get shortlisted for the interview will be assessed on their knowledge in complementary subjects i.e., in mathematics for applicants with background in Biology/Physiology/Health Sciences, etc., and in Biology/Physiology for applicants with background in Engineering /Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics, etc.
